

Be sure to check out the ISS as it makes and extra-bright pass over the Cayman Islands on the 7th of February. It rises from the NW horizon at 7:16pm. It will grow brighter as it crosses the sky, and it will disappear above the SE horizon at 7:22 as it enters Earth's shadow.

Here are some upcoming evening passes. Note that the "lower" the number for the brightness magnitude, the brighter the station will appear.

Click on the date to get a star chart and other pass details.


Green Flashes
