

Climate

- Tropical Wet (Aw) climate [Köppen system]
 - Driest month with precipitation less than 2.4 in and less that 4% of the annual precipitation
- Dry Season of mild winters (Nov Apr)
- Wet season of warm & rainy summer (May Oct)






Wet Season

- Max Average Temperature: 91°F
- Rainfall Total: 6.9 inches
- Main Producers of Precipitation:
 - Convection (producing regular afternoon showers due to higher summer temperatures)
 - Tropical Wave
 - Tropical Depression
 - Tropical Storm
 - Hurricane











Dry Season

- Min Average Temperature: 68°F
- Rainfall Totals: 2.4 inches
- Main Producer of Precipitation:
 - Cold Fronts rainfall not long lasting or plentiful and dependent on the cold front reaching south enough to reach our area.








Cold Fronts

•Light Winds




AFTER


